**INFORMATION**

**MENS AND WOMENS SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIPS 24 – 27 March**

- Competitions open to players within the handicap range of -3 to 7. Players with a handicap outside this range may be accepted by the ACA, dependant upon the number of entries received. If it is necessary to reduce entry numbers the Australian Rankings published at the closing date for entries will be used. Qualifying events, to be held immediately preceding the main events, may be held in Perth for up to 2 places in each event.
- Twenty lawns are available, 10 for each event. Up to 80 entries may be accepted in both events.
- The venues will be: Como (4), Nedlands (4), Cambridge (4), Forrest Park (2), East Fremantle (2), Victoria Park (2) and Bayswater (2). Forrest Park Croquet Club will be Headquarters.
- Events will be played as best of three knockouts. Players will be expected to play 3 best of three matches in two days for Rounds 1 to 3 and also for Rounds 4 to 6. Players may have to play up to nine games in each two day segment of the events.
- Optional Plate events will be conducted for those knocked out in Rounds 1 to 3. The format will be determined when entry numbers are known and will most likely be block play, but a progressive Swiss may be necessary.
- Registration will be an informal 'drop-in' on Friday 23 March at Forrest Park Croquet Club from 11.00am to 6.00pm. Dinner tickets and programs will be available for collection at the same time.
- Players will be emailed/sent a copy of the draw for the events, details of venue locations and the conditions of the events after the completion of the draw.

- Hoops will be set at 3 11/16 inches, with an upward tolerance of 1/32 of an inch at half ball height (Regulation 1(c) (3)).
