<b>Draw:</b>	Conducted by the Executive Director in conjunction with the ACA Tournament and Selection Committee using the ACA Seeding and Draw procedures within 3 days of entries closing. The ranking list current at that time will be used for seeding purposes

### Events

#### **1. Australian Association Croquet Handicap Singles (Holder: Chris Grant)**

27-31 October. Entries are limited to 64 players in order of receipt. Play will commence in seeded blocks (up to 8 players per block). Based on games and then net points, an equal number of players from each block will proceed to the knockout phase of the event. Players are expected to play up to 3 games per day. Time limits will be imposed.

A Plate event will be held for players who do not qualify for a second round of the Australian Association Croquet Handicap Singles using an appropriate format.

#### **2. Australian Association Croquet Handicap Doubles (Holders: Chris Grant & Ian Grant)**

25-26 October. Entries are limited to 32 pairs. Partners are allocated on a high low handicap basis. Play will commence in seeded blocks (usually 4 pairs per block). Based on games and then net points, an equal number of pairs from each block will proceed to the knockout phase of the event. Players expected to play up to 3 games per day. Time limits will be imposed.
