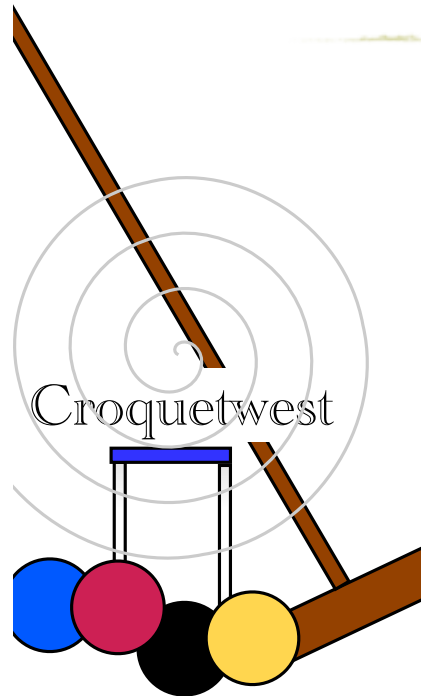

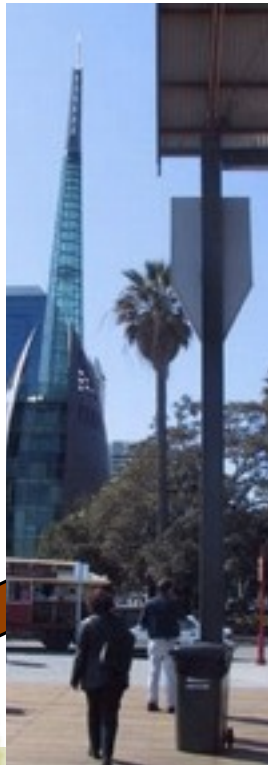
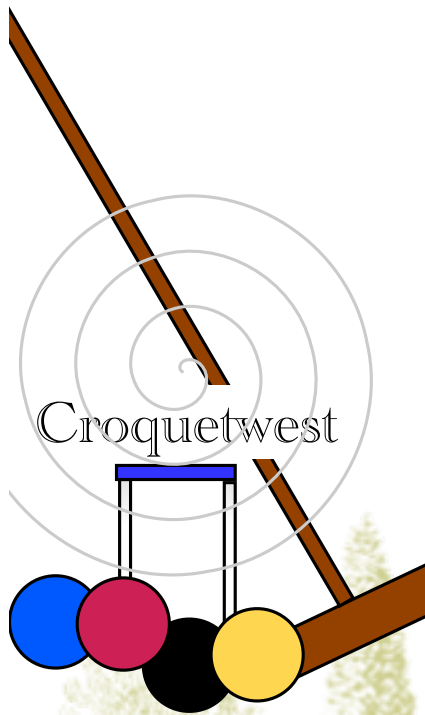

## PERTH ACCOMMODATION

The three Perth championship venues are on average approximately 12 km apart and situated to the south, east and west of Perth City.

The accommodation in this guide is by no means limited to this list and it is advised that visitors make their own enquiries and accommodation choices. This is merely a guide.

Perth City is central to all venues, whereas Como is almost 14 km from Floreat and would involve a 28 km round trip if accommodation were chosen near one of these two clubs.

### PERTH ATTRACTIONS

**Kings Park** overlooking the City. Beautiful views of the Swan River and Perth City, botanical gardens, restaurants.

**Bell Tower** see and hear the glorious bells of St Martin-in-the Field as they are rung by groups of bellringers. Great views of the city and river.

**Art Gallery, Museum, Northbridge restaurants** all located on the north side of the railway line and in walking distance of city accommodation.

**Ferry to South Perth** a short trip from the City's Barrack Street Jetty will take you across the Narrows to South Perth where there are many coffee shops and restaurants.

**Northbridge** is a short walk across Perth's train station. It is a cosmopolitan collection of clubs, restaurants and diverse dining.

### Further afield:

**Cottesloe** beachside dining and views to Rottnest Island.

**Fremantle** historic harbour city with markets cafes restaurants and seafood dining at the marina. Accessible by rail, road and ferry.

**Swan Valley** if you want a sample of some of Margaret River's attractions but don't have time to travel 300 km, Swan Valley is worth a visit for wine and beer tasting, specialty produce and art.

**Hillarys Boat Harbour** dining and shopping precinct near northern beaches.

**Rottnest Island** Take a trip on the ferry and walk or cycle around the bays, visit the restaurants and see the local quokkas.
