Entry fees:	Event 1: \$130 If entering the Plate ONLY: \$65 Event 2: \$75 per player If entering the Plate ONLY: \$37.50 per player Full time students (under 25) are entitled to a 50% reduction in fees
Prizes:	Event 1: Winner \$1000; Runner-up \$500; 3 rd \$300; 4 th \$100 Event 2: Winner \$250 each; Runner-up \$100 each
Functions & Sales:	Welcoming function BBQ's (2): approx \$15 per person Polo Shirts (specially designed for the event): approx \$40 each
Draw:	Conducted by the Executive Director in conjunction with the ACA Tournament and Selection Committee using the ACA Seeding and Draw procedures within 3 days of entries closing. The ranking list current at that time will be used for seeding purposes
Registration:	At first venue of play for each player
Catering:	Tea & Coffee provided free of charge; Lunches, Morning & Afternoon tea available

Events

1. Australian Open Singles Championship (Holder: Stephen Mulliner)

23-28 November. Entries will be limited to 56 based on World Ranking. Play will commence with 8 seeded blocks (single games). Based on Regulation 19(a)(5), 32 players will qualify for re-seeded XYZ draw (knockout, best of 3 games). Semi-finals and final will be best of 5 games. All games will be time-limited.

1 (a) Plate: The Plate event is designed to maximise the amount of play and will be conducted as large blocks or Swiss, with semi-finals and final to be best of 3 knockout (if time/entries allow). Players may enter the Plate event as follows:

- players not qualifying for a place in knock-out phase of the main event, and,
- players who are reserves in the main events, and,
- players entering the Plate Event directly (not through the main event).

2. Australian Doubles Championship (Holders: Paddy Chapman & Miranda Morgan)

20-22 November. Play will commence with seeded blocks (single games). Based on Regulation 19(a)(5), 4 pairs qualify for the knockout phase of the event (best of 3 games if time allows). All games will be time-limited.

2 (a) Plate: A Plate event may be held if time allows, designed to maximise the amount of play and will be conducted as large blocks or Swiss (single games). Entry as for the singles Plate.
