<b>Entry fees:</b>	Singles: \$80. If entering the Plate only: \$40 Doubles: \$50 each Full time students (under 25) are entitled to a 50% reduction in fees
<b>Functions:</b>	Welcoming Function: At St Leonards, barbecue, 5pm, Sunday 23 October, \$15. Presentation Dinner: Newstead Hotel, 7pm, Sunday 30 October, a la carte.
<b>Draw:</b>	Conducted by the Tournament Committee in conjunction with the Selection Committee using the ACA Seeding and Draw procedures.
<b>Registration and Practice:</b>	St Leonards, after 2:00pm, Sunday 23 October. Courts will be available for practice.
<b>Catering:</b>	Tea and coffee (included in entry fee), lunch available
<b>Conditions:</b>	Detailed conditions are in the Handbook on the ACA website and in the Programme issued at Registration.
<b>Handicap Cards:</b>	Players must present cards at Registration and complete them after every game.

### **Australian Association Croquet Handicap Singles (Holder: Bob Beattie)**

26-30 October. Entries are limited to 64 players in order of receipt. Play will commence in seeded blocks (up to 8 players per block). Based on games and then net points, players will proceed to the knockout phase. Players are expected to play up to 3 games per day. Time limits will be imposed.

A Plate event will be held for players who do not qualify for, or lose in the first round of, the knockout

### **Australian Association Croquet Handicap Doubles (Holders: Tony Hall & Kathleen Lines)**

24-25 October. Entries are limited to 32 pairs. Partners are allocated on a high low handicap basis. Play will commence in seeded blocks (usually 4 pairs per block). Based on games and then net points, pairs will proceed to the knockout phase of the event. Players expected to play up to 3 games per day. Time limits will be imposed.
