**STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR ACA GOLF CROQUET EVENTS**

1. All events will be played under the WCF Rules of Golf Croquet adopted by Croquet Australia.
2. The Australian Handicapping System is in force for this Tournament, and entrants are to have a current Golf Croquet handicap. A handicap may be assigned by the Tournament Manager in terms of the Appendix to the Rules of Golf Croquet.
3. Players are to ensure that they have their ACA Handicap Cards with them to present to the Tournament Manager or his representative before each event commences. Handicap cards should be completed after each game. If players reach a trigger point their handicap changes immediately.
4. Croquet Australia reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason and to have final arbitration on any question that may arise.
5. All competitors who have not already provided an address, telephone number or email address at which messages can reach them during the events should provide this information during registration.
6. Courts will be available for practice up to 7.45am each day and after the completion of play for the day, subject to club requirements for dressing courts and maintenance. The Venue Manager's approval should be sought for such practice, and players assistance in preparing and clearing lawns will ensure that this practice can continue.
7. Hoops are to be set as near as possible to 3 11/16 inches. To allow for inaccuracies in gauges, balls, hoops and setting techniques, a tolerance of  $\pm 1/32$  inch is allowed. Players are asked to help set the hoops at the start of the day if necessary.
8. Hoops may be reset at any time on the request of the player in play. In double-banked games, hoops may be reset on the request of a player in play subject to approval of the double-banked player on court. The double-banked player on court may not reasonably withhold permission unless they are about to use the hoop which is to be reset.
9. Dawson International balls will be used.
10. Court allocations may be changed by the Venue Manager and games will be double banked as required.
11. There will be a Referee at each court to act as required. Where there are not sufficient referees present to be in charge of all games, referees will be supervisory.
12. Players' attention is drawn to Rule 14 of the WCF Golf Croquet Rules book regarding Etiquette, which also covers expedition in play and to Condition 65 of the ACA Handbook concerning Conduct of Players in ACA events.
13. Players are required to wear predominantly white clothing and appropriate footwear. Club, State or National Uniforms are also permitted. Predominantly white clothing means any article with more than 75% of its surface area white. White means white, not grey or off-white (this condition does not apply to wet weather clothing hats or caps). Any player presenting at the venue in clothing that does not meet this criteria will need to change or will not be permitted to participate in the event. The Executive Committee may amend these rules if necessary. Flat-soled footwear must be worn.
14. Matches shall commence at **8.00 am** sharp unless otherwise indicated. Players are requested to be at their designated court before the scheduled starting time.
15. All games will be un-timed. However, the Tournament or Venue Manager may impose a time limit if necessary.
16. Players are allowed a break of up to 5 minutes between matches and a lunch break of up to 30 minutes, but such breaks can be waived by mutual agreement of the players. No break is allowed between games in multiple game matches - games should be 'seamless' and players are expected to commence play in the second and third games immediately after the completion of the previous game. The Tournament and Venue Managers will ensure games go on expeditiously to enable completion of the scheduled program.

17. It is mandatory for players to inform the Venue Manager if they wish to leave the venue for any reason.
18. The Venue Manager will decide whether play in any match should continue if the weather is deteriorating.
19. The Tournament Manager in consultation with the Executive of Croquet Australia may make any alterations to the program, draw and other arrangements as are necessary in order to complete the tournament in the time available. If available, lights may be used at the Tournament or Venue Manager's discretion.
20. An appeals committee under ACA comprising two representatives of the organising body and the Tournament Referee shall determine any matters that are in dispute during the course of the tournament.
21. Should an overseas player win an event, the perpetual trophy shall remain in Australia in the custody of the Executive Director of Croquet Australia. All winners of trophies are requested to obtain a quote for the cost of appropriate engraving and submit that quote to the Executive Director of Croquet Australia before proceeding.

### **SPECIFIC CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

Tournament Headquarters is Toombul (4 courts). Other clubs being used include Windsor (4 courts), Wynnum (4 courts), East Brisbane (3 courts), Graceville (3 courts) and Stephens (4 courts). Programs will be available on the ACA website, plus hard copies at Registration at Toombul on Friday 26 August between 4-6 pm.

#### **Golf Croquet Gold Medal of Australia (24 – 26 August 2011)**

1. Each player shall play each other player once in a round robin of best-of-three 13 point games. Players are seeded, and order of play has been determined by the latest available World Ranking List.
2. Any competitor forfeiting a match shall be scratched from the competition and scores for and against shall be deleted from the results.
3. Positions shall be determined in accordance with the ACA AC Regulations for Tournaments. The winner of this event will receive the Australian Golf Croquet Gold Medal and the second placed player will receive the Australian Golf Croquet Silver Medal.

#### **Golf Croquet Men's & Women's Singles Championship of Australia (27 – 30 August 2011)**

1. The Draw was conducted by the ACA Tournament and GC Selection Committees using the ACA Seeding and Draw procedures. The World Ranking List current at that time was used for seeding purposes. The format for the Singles is as follows.
  - a) Blocks seeded, with members of the same family placed in different blocks, and players from the same State spread between blocks. Each player to play each other player in the block once in a round robin of 13 point games.
  - b) Players will be drawn for the knock-out phase based on final placings in initial blocks. In the Men's, all players except the player coming last in each block will proceed to the final 32 knockout stage of the event. In the Women's, players placed 1-4 in each block will proceed to the final 16 knockout stage of the event. Placings will be determined by net games, then net points or other method at the Tournament Manager's discretion.
  - c) The knockout will be played as best of three 13 point games, with the Final played as best of five 13 point games (time permitting).
  - d) The Plate event will be conducted as large blocks or Swiss with a knockout final. Players may enter the Plate event as follows:
    - i. players not allocated a place in the main events, or
    - ii. players who are reserves in the main events, or
    - iii. players entering the Plate Event directly (not through the main event).

## WCF Interstate Shield for Golf Croquet Teams (31 August – 4 September 2011)

1. States may name no fewer than 8 players (4 men and 4 women) nor more than 10 players (5 men and 5 women). Reserves are permitted under Clause 5 below. If one or more State(s) is/are not able to provide a full team of four men and four women, but can provide at least two men and two women, the Host State or other States, in consultation with said State, may provide additional players to make up a full team and allow the State to participate;
2. A playing or non-playing Captain shall be appointed by each State and advised to the Executive Director;
3. The draw was seeded by the ACA Events Committee based on the results of the previous interstate teams event for Golf Croquet. Tests will be played as follows:
  - Day 1 : Team 3 vs Team 5, Team 1 vs Team 6, Team 2 vs Team 4
  - Day 2 : Team 1 vs Team 4, Team 2 vs Team 5, Team 3 vs Team 6
  - Day 3 : Team 4 vs Team 6, Team 2 vs Team 3, Team 1 vs Team 5
  - Day 4 : Team 2 vs Team 6, Team 4 vs Team 5, Team 1 vs Team 3
  - Day 5 : Team 1 vs Team 2, Team 3 vs Team 4, Team 5 vs Team 6
4. On the day scheduled for any Test:
  - i. The names of singles players in order of merit, and the doubles pairings, shall be notified by each Captain or Vice Captain to the Tournament Manager or Venue Manager at least 20 minutes before the commencement of each Test. In each Test four men players and four women players must be selected to play singles but the players selected to play doubles can be different members of the team from those playing singles. The order of play for singles matches shall be in accordance with the World Ranking List used to seed the Men's & Women's Singles Draws;
  - ii. Individual members of teams may be varied for each separate Test. Apart from the arrangements permitted under clause 5, individual members of a team may not be varied during a Test, unless a player is incapacitated by sickness or accident (but not for a pre-existing illness or condition). In such event, a substitute player, nominated under Clause 5 below may fill his or her place in the team for any match not already commenced, except for the second round of singles (see 4 iii below). Such substitution must be reported to the Captain of the opposing team and be sanctioned by the Venue Manager in consultation with the Tournament Referee
  - iii. The second round of singles must be played with the same players who played in the first round of singles of that Test, or be forfeited (7-0, 7-0). If a match is started but is unable to be completed, it will be conceded. The score in any conceded game will be recorded as 7 to the winner and the score to the opponent at the time of concession.
5. Each team shall be entitled to nominate one or more players, any of whom may, prior to the commencement of the Test, act as a substitute for a player. If the occasion arises that no substitute is readily available, a reasonable time shall be allowed to obtain a substitute, and the Team Schedule shall be adjusted accordingly. If the team concerned is unable to nominate a substitute within the given time, the match for that player shall be forfeited (7-0, 7-0).
6. Each team will play every other team once. A Test comprises twenty matches: 4 mixed doubles and 16 singles. Mixed doubles shall be played first then the singles, women versus women and men versus men.
7. Matches, each of two 13-point games, shall be played in the following order:
  - Court 1: MA1 & WA1 v MB1 & WB1, MA1 v MB2, WA1 v WB2, MA2 v MB2, WA1 v WB1.
  - Court 2: MA2 & WA2 v MB2 & WB2, WA2 v WB1, MA2 v MB1, WA2 v WB2, MA1 v MB1.
  - Court 3: MA3 & WA3 v MB3 & WB3, MA3 v MB4, WA3 v WB4, MA4 v MB4, WA3 v WB3.
  - Court 4: MA4 & WA4 v MB4 & WB4, WA4 v WB3, MA4 v MB3, WA4 v WB4, MA3 v MB3.
8. Should a team be unable to complete all Tests, scores for and against that team will be deleted from the results.

9. Tests shall be decided as follows:
  1. in each Test, the team that wins the most matches, but:
  2. if matches are equal, the team that wins most net games, but:
  3. if scores are still equal, the team that wins most net hoops, but:
  4. if scores are still equal, the Test shall be a tie and each team shall score half (1/2) a Test point.
  5. a team winning the Test shall score one (1) Test point.
  
10. The winner of the Interstate Shield for Golf Croquet Teams shall be decided as follows:
  1. the State Team scoring the greatest number of Test points, but:
  2. If Test points are equal, the team that wins the greatest number of matches in all Tests, but:
  3. if matches are equal, the greatest number of games in all Tests; but
  4. if the number of games are equal, the greatest number of net hoops in all Tests; but
  5. if the number of net hoops are equal, the winner of the Test between the teams.  
If this Test was tied, the trophy shall be shared by both State teams.
  
11. The Tournament Manager is authorised to make decisions to vary the conditions of play as required; and in particular to ensure that as far as possible, each Interstate Shield Test is completed in one day.

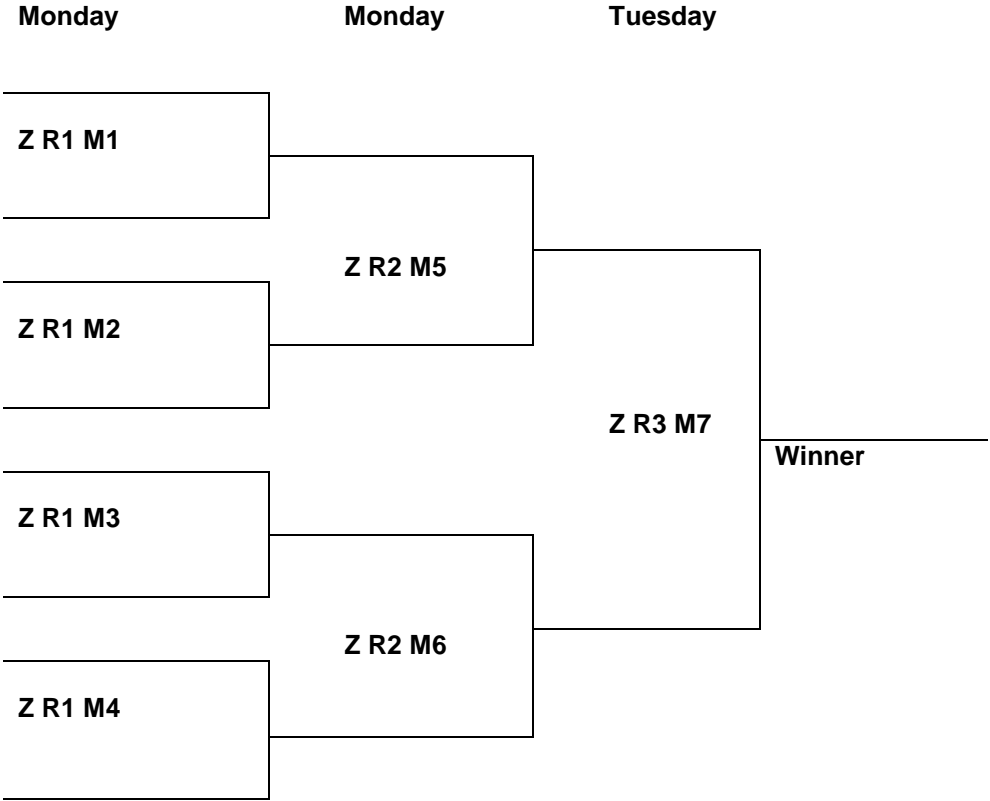
