Prizes:	Events 2 & 3: Winner \$300; Runner-up \$150; Third \$100.
Draw:	Conducted by the ACA Tournament, Event and AC Selection Committees using the ACA Seeding and Draw procedures. The world ranking list current at that time will be used for seeding purposes

2. Australian Men's Championship (Holder: Robert Fletcher)

17-20 March at Forrest Park, Cambridge, Nedlands – finals at Forrest Park. The format is single life knockout or other format depending on entries. All matches will be best of 3 games, except the final which will be best of 5 if time permits. An XYZ shall be played at the round of 16. There will be a play-off for 3rd/4th place. All games will be time-limited.

(a) Plate:

First and second round losers in the main event proceed to the Plate which is designed to maximise the amount of play and will be conducted as large blocks or Swiss, with a single life knockout final. Players may also enter direct without playing in the main event. All games will be single life and time limited.

3. Australian Women's Championship (Holder: Trish Devlin)

17-20 March at Como, Bayswater, Victoria Park, East Fremantle – finals at Como. The format is single life knockout. All matches will be best of 3 games. Subject to entries, an XYZ shall be played at the round of 8. Losers in the round of 8 play in the Y event. Losers of the semi-finals play in the Z event. All games will be time-limited.

(a) Plate:
