**Rich River Golf Club Resort, Moama, NSW.
Registration 11 Oct 2008. Play 12-18 October 2008
All play at Rich River Croquet Club**

- Competition is open to all players. Entries will be limited to 64 players. If entries exceed the maximum numbers the first 64 entries in will be accepted. A total of 6 courts will be used (including 1 bowls green). All at Rich River Golf Club Resort. Games will be double banked.
- The Handicap Doubles (Hi/Lo Format) will be block play. Size of blocks will depend on number of entries. Two pairs in each block will proceed to final knockout. **(The Event Manager will draw Doubles partners unless otherwise specified.)**
- The Handicap Singles will be block play (preferably blocks of 8). Two players from each block will proceed to the knock out event. Quarter finals, semi finals and finals will be played.
- Blocks will be determined on a random basis with same family/club/state conflicts minimised.
- All players must have a current AHS authorised handicap card. Handicaps may be adjusted by the Tournament Handicapper during the events.
- Games will commence at 8.00 am each day with most players playing 2 scheduled games per day. Game times will be 2 1/2 hours for block play in the Doubles and Singles. Quarter finals and semi finals will be 2 1/2 hours and single life. The final will be untimed and best of three. All games will be played to Regulation 15(c).
- As there will usually be time between games it is expected that players will be ready to commence games having tossed and be at the appropriate court before the end of the previous game.
- Registration will be an informal 'drop-in' on Saturday 11 October at Rich River from 10.00am. Also on 11 October a Referees Introduction session will be held from 1.30pm including an explanation of the recent changes to the Laws.
- Players will be sent a copy of their receipt and the draw. Those opting to receive their copies of the draw via email will not receive a mailed copy.
- Hoops will be set at 3 11/16" with an upward tolerance of 1/32" . Dawson International Balls will be used.
- Conditions of play may change depending on number of entries. Australian Regulations for Tournaments will be used.
- All winners of trophies are directed to obtain a quote for the price of engraving their details on the trophy and submit that quote to the ACA Executive Director for approval before proceeding with engraving.
